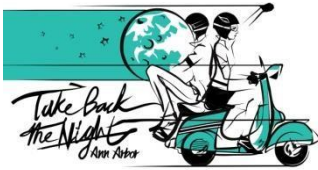


# Take Back the Night - Ann Arbor
